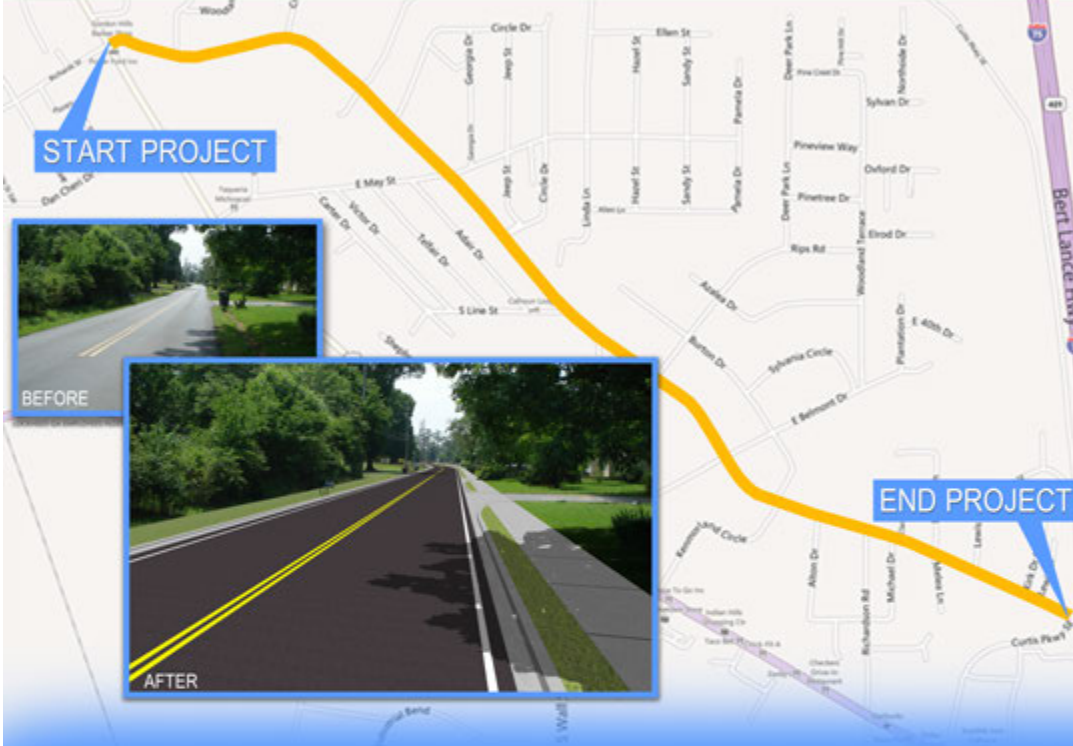
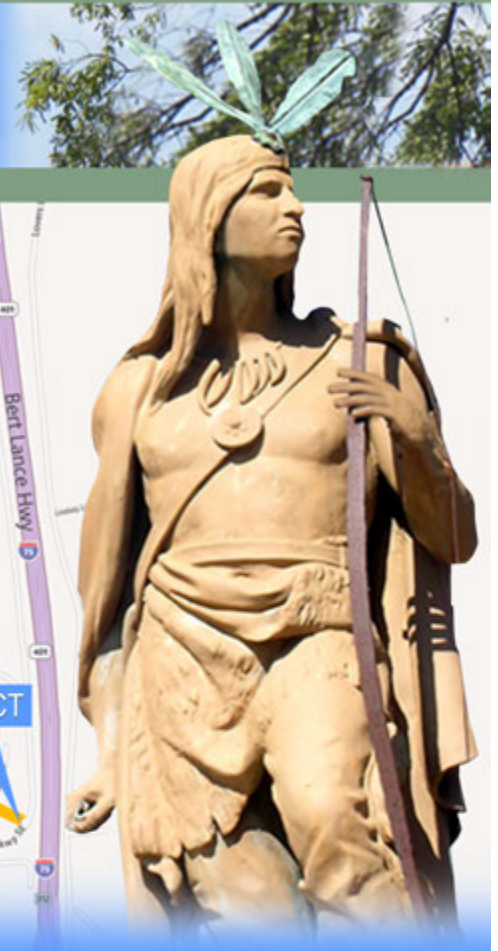


# PETERS STREET SAFETY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

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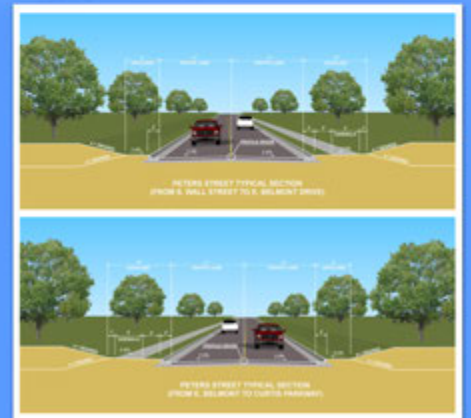

The Peters Street Safety Enhancement Project is a joint funded project between the City of Calhoun and Gordon County with the City leading the efforts. The project consists of roadway safety improvements, drainage improvements and the addition of pedestrian facilities along Peters Street from South Wall Street to Curtis Parkway - 1.9-miles total length. The project will improve existing substandard horizontal and vertical curves along this corridor at several locations, widen the travel lanes from 10-ft. to 11-ft., provide shoulder improvements including adding curb and gutter to both sides of the roadway with sidewalks along one side, and provide a smoother profile and roadway cross slopes for a better driving surface. The project is scheduled for design and right-of-way acquisition services from 2012 to 2014 and with the construction to begin in either Fall of 2014 or Spring of 2015.



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
