1 State law requires that all electrical, plumbing, heat/air and gas work must be preformed by a state licensed contractor. EXCEPTION : A homeowner may permit and perform this work on their personal property. However, when permitting work as "owner" it is a violation of state and local law to hire a non-licensed person to perform this work. The owner or member if his/her immediate family must perform this work. When hiring a licensed contractor to perform work, that work should be permitted under the licensed contractor's name . Both state and local authorities may prosecute violators .
