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The Gordon County Board of Commissioners accepted sealed written Bids from qualified vendors for the 2018 LMIG off-system safety bid, for stripping and replacing signage on specified roads in Gordon County. The Bid was posted on the county's web site, posted upon the State of Georgia procurement web site and advertised in the Calhoun Times on October 4 and 11, 2017. The deadline to submit the sealed bids was 2:00 p.m. October 27,, 2017. County staff opened the bids received at that time in a public opening. Below is the response:

**RECOMMENDATION**

After reviewing the bids the Public Works department recommends the bid be awarded to Brown Asphalt Maintenance' bid is \$64,463.50.

This expenditure will come from the budget for Public Works paving and the Public Works Department is to complete the conditions of the grant to receive the matching \$37,000.00 from GDOT.
