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PROPOSED MOTION FOR INTENT TO ABANDON ROADS:

I move, following a discussion by the Board of Commissioners of a request to abandon **a portion of East May Street (from Linda Lane to Peters Street); Linda Lane and Peters Street**, that the Board has determined and does certify that the roads identified above, have ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by these roads remaining as a part of the Gordon County Road system as all of these roads are now located adjacent to property which is located within the city limits of the City of Calhoun, and that the City of Calhoun has indicated that it is willing to incorporate these roads into the city road system and is willing and desires to take over these designated roads.

I further move that Gordon County shall notify all property owners located thereon and the public in general as required by O.C.G.A Section 32-7-2 of its intent to abandon these roads and shall schedule a public hearing on this issue.

***NOTE: Should the Board wish to proceed with the abandonment of these 3 roads, then notice of a public hearing to consider these requests will be published in the Calhoun Times for two (2) weeks. A public hearing to consider these requests to abandon these 3 roads would be scheduled then for a regular commission meeting. In addition, all adjoining property owners must be notified prior to the public hearing.
