

STATE OF GEORGIA**COUNTY OF GORDON****AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, Article 9, Section 2, Paragraph 3 of the Georgia Constitution specifically confers upon **GORDON COUNTY, GEORGIA**, a political subdivision of the State of Georgia (hereinafter referred to as “the County”), certain supplementary powers and all implied powers necessary to carry out said supplementary powers and provide services to include public health facilities and services, parks, recreational programs, libraries, archives, and arts and science programs and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the County has been requested by PREVENT CHILD ABUSE GORDON COUNTY, INC, (hereinafter referred to as “the Service Provider”) to furnish funds in the amount of \$2,730.00 for the County’s 2014 fiscal year to allow the Service Provider to perform the following activities promoting the safety, health, peace, security, good order, comfort, convenience and general welfare of the citizens of the County, to wit:

Parenting and nursing classes to parents and their children, ages 0-18, who are mandated by the courts to attend where abuse and neglect has already occurred, and those who voluntarily feel the need to attend classes in an all out effort to prevent child abuse and neglect by teaching parenting and nurturing skills to provide parents with ways to discipline and nurture their children while teaching them how to become productive citizens through learning communication techniques, and to empower families so that they can contribute to the safety, health, peace, security, good order, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the citizens of Gordon County ; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Gordon County, Georgia consider the services to be performed by the Service Provider necessary for the general welfare of the citizens of Gordon County;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the County and Service Provider do hereby agree as

follows:

1. Service Provider will undertake and perform the following activities, projects and

programs (hereinafter referred to as "the Service Project") during the County's 2014 fiscal year:

Parenting and nursing classes to parents and their children, ages 0-18, who are mandated by the courts to attend where abuse and neglect has already occurred, and those who voluntarily feel the need to attend classes in an all out effort to prevent child abuse and neglect by teaching parenting and nurturing skills to provide parents with ways to discipline and nurture their children while teaching them how to become productive citizens through learning communication techniques, and to empower families so that they can contribute to the safety, health, peace, security, good order, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the citizens of Gordon County.

2. Service Provider will provide to the County a report on or before December 31, 2013

and May 31, 2014 identifying the activities, projects and programs performed or completed

during said reporting period. Said report shall identify the costs and expenditures for same as well as the number of County residents served.

3. County will pay to the Service Provider the sum of \$2,730.00 for the Service Projects.

4. Any property, other than real estate, purchased by the Service Provider with the funds paid by the County hereunder shall become the property of the County in the event the Service Provider ceases to exist as a legal entity or abandons the Service Project. In such event, the County may take immediate possession of said property.
