Dear Property Owner:

According to the official property records of Gordon County, Georgia, you are the owner of record of real property adjoining Peters Street. This road is currently listed as part of the Gordon County Road System. At its regular meeting of November 20, 2012, the Gordon County Board of Commissioners approved the initiation of the process required by the Official Code of Georgia Annotated Section 32-7-2 for the removal of this road from the Gordon County Road System. If the Board approves the removal of your road from the county road system, then the City of Calhoun has agreed to assume ownership of this road and to add this road to the City of Calhoun Street System. Please note that the matter under consideration only concerns the road right-of-way itself (which is currently owned by Gordon County), and not the adjoining parcels of real estate which are owned by you and your neighbors.

A public hearing will be held on **August 6, 2013, at 6:00 p.m.** in the conference room of the Gordon County Administration Building concerning this matter. A map depicting the proposed road to be removed from the Gordon County Road System is available for public inspection in my office located in the Gordon County Administration Building.
