**REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION OF  
2013 APPLICATION GORDON COUNTY  
MALT BEVERAGE, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE**

Mr. Rasheed R. Virani, as Chief Operating Officer of Sony Enterprises, Inc. D/B/A “SNR Groceries #1”, respectfully request that the Board of Commissioners of Gordon County reconsider his Application for Malt Beverage, Wine and Liquor License and shows the Board as follows:

1.

Mr. Virani submitted his most recent Gordon County Application for Malt Beverage, Wine and Liquor License on January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

2.

Mr. Varani appeared before the Gordon County Board of Commissioners, at a public hearing, on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2013 to request the approval of his application. Mr. Virani’s application’s was denied upon vote of the Board of Commissioners at that same meeting.

3.

Subsequent to Mr. Virani’s May 7<sup>th</sup> appearance, he has obtained counsel from the law firm Miles Patterson Hansford Tallant LLC. With the assistance of counsel, Mr. Virani has taken new measures and implemented detailed procedures to ensure “SNR Groceries #1” compliance with all State laws, local ordinances and create an overall atmosphere which will reflect positive on the community.

4.

The procedures implemented by Mr. Virani include:

- (a) Mr. Virani shall actively participate in the daily activities and operation of “SNR Groceries #1” and be physically present at the business for at a minimum 20 hours

per week;

- (b) Mr. Virani shall hire a full-time general manager to oversee the operations of “SNR Groceries #1” on a full time basis and this general manager shall report directly to Mr. Virani;
- (c) Mr. Virani shall run a complete background check on all employees prior any hiring decision;
- (d) Mr. Virani shall mandate that all employees of “SNR Groceries #1” take training courses and seminars on identifying fake identification and calculating whether a potential customer is of the legal age to purchase alcohol.


