No. 77 (House Bill No. 755).

AN ACT

To amend an Act entitled "An Act to provide for the compensation of the coroner
of Gordon County," approved March 25, 1986 (Ga. L. 1986, p. 4718), so as to
change the compensation of the coroner; to provide for the appointment of two
deputy coroners and for their salaries; to provide an effective date; to repeal
conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

An Act entitled "An Act to provide for the compensation of the coroner of Gordon
County," approved March 25, 1986 (Ga. L. 1986, p. 4718), is amended by striking
Sections 1 and 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1.

The coroner of Gordon County shall be compensated in the amount of \$1,000.00
per month. Such compensation shall be paid from the funds of Gordon County
and shall be in lieu of all fees, costs, commissions, allowances, moneys, and all
other emoluments and perquisites of whatever kind which shall be allowed the
coroners of the various counties of this state. All such fees, costs, commissions,
allowances, moneys, and other emoluments and perquisites of whatever kind
shall be paid into the county treasury at least once each month.

SECTION 2.

The coroner of Gordon County may appoint two deputy coroners to serve at the
pleasure of the coroner, to be replaced at his or her order; and to appoint
additional deputy coroners to serve only in the event of mass fatalities. The

deputy coroners for said county shall receive their compensation (as provided by state law.)

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2002.

SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.

repeal provisions relating to the service of the clerk of the superior court as clerk
