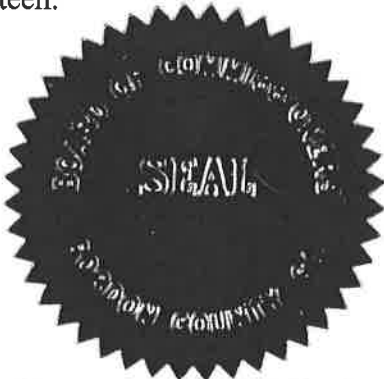
WHEREAS, Veterans Day is a time for our hearts and thoughts to turn to those who were disabled while serving their country, and the sacrifices and hardships they endure; and
