The Gordon County Board of Commissioners has been awarded a SORNA (Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act) grant by the Georgia Criminal Justice Coordinating Council. The specific purpose of this grant is for the purchase of a new LiveScan fingerprint machine (Eagle Print Palm System) whereby all Sex Offenders required to be registered with the Gordon County Sheriff's Office will be fingerprinted to include capturing palm prints of all sex offenders being fingerprinted to comply with the Adam Walsh Act.

The amount of the grant award is \$ 17,480.00. The overall cost of then new equipment to include installation and training is \$ 19,627.00. The additional amount over the grant award will be paid from the Sheriff's Office budget.

I am requesting that this grant be approved by the Board of Commissioners as well as appropriate budget amendments etc. necessary to go forward with the grant.
