All financial reports have been examined and all are accepted as submitted. We appreciate and thank these officials for the job each is doing.



5. We authorize Jonathan D. Purser our Foreperson to call this Grand Jury back into session any time during our appointed term, if he warrants it necessary.


6. We recommend these presentments be spread upon the minutes of the Court and be published in the legal organ of Gordon County.
