

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Re: Amendment to ULDC Sec. 11-413. Terms of members of the Historic Planning Commission

Recommending an amendment to ULDC Sec. 11-413 to allow members of the Historic Planning Commission to succeed themselves for consecutive three year terms at the discretion of the Board of Commissioners of Gordon County, Georgia as follows:

ULDC Sec. 11-413

Members of the HPC shall serve at the pleasure of the Gordon County Board of Commissioners, generally serving three-year terms. ~~Members may not serve more than two (2) consecutive terms.~~ Members may serve subsequent additional three years terms at the discretion of the Board of Commissioners of Gordon County, Georgia. In order to achieve staggered terms, initial appointments shall be two (2) members for one (1) year, two (2) members for two (2) years, and one (1) member for three (3) years. Members shall not receive a salary, but may be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.
