

**Whereas**, Sec. 4-36 of the Gordon County Code of Ordinances incorporates certain Minimum Standard Building Codes for administration and enforcement in Gordon County. Pertaining to Electrical Codes, Sec. 4-36(C)(1)b. states:

b. *Electrical.* The provisions of the National Electrical Code shall apply to the installation of electrical systems, including alterations, repairs, replacement, equipment, appliances, fixtures, fittings and appurtenances thereto...

**Whereas**, Section 4-36 (c)(1)(b) is limited by the specific requirement of Sec. 4-51(d)(3) which requires in part:

“Wire *size.* Minimum wire size allowed for branch circuit work shall be #12 AWG.”

**Whereas**, the National Electrical Code provides sufficient guidance, requirements and specifications for branch circuit wiring exclusive of the specific requirement of Sec. 4-51(d)(3).

**Now Therefore, it is hereby Resolved** that Gordon County Ordinance Sec. 4-51(d)(3) is deleted such that branch circuit work shall be performed as required by the National Electrical Code.
