The Limestone Valley Resource Conservation and Development Council is requesting that Gordon County appoint two representatives to the RC&D Council for the 2017-2018 period. Through the "citizen representative" position, Limestone Valley seeks skilled individuals that will help diversify the Council, facilitate the mission of the organization, and provide financial and technical advice. The appointment can be a private citizen or a representative of Gordon County.
