

## SUMMARY OF AMBULANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT

The Current Ambulance Services agreement between Gordon County and Adventist Health System/Georgia, Inc. ("Provider") became effective on July 1, 2003. The agreement has been renewed twice and the Provider has asked for a third renewal by amendment to the original contract. The information contained below summarizes critical elements of the current agreement, as renewed, and the proposed third renewal.

Under the **original contract**, the Provider agreed to provide:

1. 3 advanced life support units; 1 basic life support unit; and, 1 basic or advanced unit as on call back-up.
2. Appropriate staffing.
3. On call staff.
4. Ambulance Service to prisoners at \$200 for a one way trip billed to the County.
5. Ambulance Service billed to Gordon County at the normal emergency rate for county volunteers and employees.
6. Ambulance Service to mass gatherings at no additional charge.
7. Community Education and Health screenings.
8. CPR and first responder training.
9. Communication Equipment.
10. Comply with County Emergency protocols.
11. Reporting, inspection, billing, no restocking fee, physician medical provider, infectious disease control plan and dispatch records.

The County agreed to do the following under the original contract:

1. Adequate housing on eastern part of the county. (2 sleeping rooms, one day room, one bay, kitchen, showers and restroom with utilities paid by provider.
2. Payment of licenses fees.
3. Fuel subsidy of \$15,000.
4. Financial subsidy of \$14,583.33 per month (\$174,999.96 per year).

The **First Amendment** changed the following terms which remained the same in the **Second Amendment**:

1. Financial Subsidy of \$19,583.33 per month (\$235,000 per year).
2. Fuel Subsidy of \$45,000 per year.

The **Third Amendment** proposes changes to the following:

1. Financial subsidy increased to \$249,000 per year.
2. Fuel Subsidy increased to \$65,000 per year.
