

TASK ORDER NO. 2018-01

To the AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL CONSULTING SERVICES
For Gordon County Highway 136 Connection Chert Pit Expansion

This Task Order, made and entered into by and between GORDON COUNTY hereinafter called the "CLIENT" and ATLANTIC COAST CONSULTING, INC., hereinafter called the "CONSULTANT", shall be incorporated into and become a part of the AGREEMENT FOR GENERAL CONSULTING SERVICES (the "AGREEMENT") entered into by the parties hereto on December 20, 2005.

A. PURPOSE

This Task Order authorizes and directs the CONSULTANT to proceed with assisting the CLIENT in providing engineering design and permitting assistance for the expansion of the existing Chert Pit on Highway 136 Connection.

B. CONSULTANT'S SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Scope of Services, dated June 5, 2018, is enumerated in Exhibit A. It is entitled Gordon County Highway 136 Connection Chert Pit Expansion Surface Mining Permitting and consists of two (2) pages.

C. CONSULTANT'S COMPENSATION

As consideration for providing the services enumerated within Item B (Exhibit A) of this Task Order, the CLIENT shall pay the CONSULTANT for this Task Order as enumerated in the attached Exhibit B.

Project Understanding

Gordon County Board of Commissioners desires assistance from Atlantic Coast Consulting, Inc. (ACC) with tasks associated with revising the footprint of the existing mine (Surface Mining Land Use Plan (SMLUP)) permit #596-07 located at 5114 Sugar Valley Road, Sugar Valley, Georgia 30746. Gordon County desires to expand the surface mine operations and obtain the proper permitting from the Surface Mine Unit of Georgia EPD.

Based on this project understanding, ACC proposes the following scope of work by task:

Task 1 – Revisions to the Permitted Plans

ACC will coordinate with the County to fully understand the expansion area desired within the existing surface mine. Upon receipt of all available topographic and boundary survey information, as well as all delineated wetlands information, ACC will produce permitting documents to include grading plans, reclamation plans, erosion control plans and details for the expansion. ACC will use available stormwater management design data to modify the stormwater plan to accommodate the expansion.

Task 2 – EPD Surface Mine Permit Amendment Submittal

Georgia EPD Surface Mine Unit has a process for amending current SMLUPs. ACC will prepare and submit the AMENDMENT application, revised SMLUP plan and Stormwater Management Plan revisions to EPD for review. The amendment application requires the description of the requested revisions to be defined as part of the application. The SMLUP plans will incorporate the requested changes to the existing mine and reflect the expansion of the mine and proposed grading.

Once the SMLUP is approved bonding requirements will be requested. ACC will assist in preparing the bond estimate quantities.

Task 3 – SWPPP Production

ACC will prepare a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) to reflect the existing surface mine and the expansion area. This will include the plans and supporting submittal documentation. ACC will work with the County to identify the proper SWPPP team members. ACC will prepare the SWPPP map exhibits for inclusion into the site SWPPP manual. The exhibits will be provided in Autocad and .pdf formats. ACC will utilize the most recent aerial topography for background.

Task 4 –Notice of Intent (NOI)

As part of the Surface Mine permit expansion process, a copy of a Notice of Intent (NOI) for Stormwater Discharge Associated with Industrial Activities General Permit GAR050000 will be generated and be included in the submittal. This will be completed after preparation of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan for the facility.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- Permit application under the new surface mining rules is not required – only an amendment to the existing permit
- Wetlands permitting is by others
- 2015 aerial survey will be provided in ACAD format
- Surveying services described above are provided by others
- Local LDA permitting is not required as part of this task order
- All permitting fees will be paid by others

Exhibit B

Consultant's Compensation Method

When the CLIENT authorizes the CONSULTANT to proceed with the work outlined in Item B of the Task Order, CLIENT agrees to pay the CONSULTANT monthly, for work completed, on the basis of the standard hourly billing rates in effect when services are provided by the CONSULTANT's employees of various labor grades, not to exceed \$10,000.00 without CLIENT approval.

Direct expenses (such as travel, subsistence, field equipment, communications, subconsultant services, etc.) are reimbursable at cost plus five percent.
