I live on Doe Lane which is in District 5 of Gordon County. For the past 12 days, Doe Lane has been under at least 2 feet of standing water. Doe Lane is a cul-de-sac. The only way for residents to get to their homes is to drive through the flooding or park before it and walk around the flooding through yards.

I contacted Public Works last week and was told there was nothing that could be done either now to fix or in the future to prevent this problem. This is an unacceptable solution. The residents of Doe Lane are tax paying members of this community and have the right to be able to access their homes safely. Right now, if there was an emergency, emergency personnel could not get to the homes. Children are having to walk around the flooding to get to the school bus. My driveway used to be the route for people to take to get around the flooding but at this point, there is even water across that. We have not been able to have mail delivery since 2/22.

I have attached a picture of what the road looks like today. This is the same way it has looked since 2/21 and I have pictures to show that. The county put out a road closed sign on 3/2, 10 days after the flooding started. How do you close a cul-de-sac with no plan for fixing the problem?

I will be attending the Board of Commissioners meeting tomorrow and hope that a solution can be found to this problem.
