Even though the 2020 Legislative Leadership Conference was cancelled, there are still critical actions that county officials must take to adopt the 2021 Policy Agenda.

Attached you will find a memo that outlines the process that will be used to consider and approve the 2021 Policy Agenda **here**. There are several opportunities for county officials to provide input along the way. Please familiarize yourself with the attached schedule **here** and watch for reminders from ACCG on when and how you can provide important feedback .

**The most immediate need is for your county to designate a voting delegate.** Each county may designate one person for this role, and if no designee is identified, the chairman, sole commissioner, chief executive officer or mayor becomes the county's voting delegate. Voting delegates will cast the final vote on behalf of the county through a virtual process between Sept. 24 - Oct. 1. **ACCG asks that you complete and return the attached voting delegate form by Sept. 22 so that voting credentials may be distributed in a timely manner.
