

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GORDON COUNTY TO
NOT REQUIRE THE ISSUANCE OF MOBILE HOME DECALS**

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A 48-5-492 has been revised to provide the County Board of Commissioners the authority to determine whether a decal is required to be issued and affixed to each mobile home as evidence of the payment of all ad valorem tax due by the mobile home owner; and WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Gordon County (“Board”) is the governing authority of Gordon County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the Gordon County Tax Commissioner has informed the Gordon County Board of Commissioners that the issuance of said mobile home decals is an unnecessary expense for Gordon County, and the non-issuance of the mobile home decal **does not** relieve the mobile home owner from payment of the ad valorem tax;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Gordon County that a decal is not required to be issued and affixed to each mobile home as evidence of the payment of all ad valorem tax due by the mobile home owner; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that nothing in this resolution shall relieve the mobile home owner from payment of all applicable ad valorem taxes, or the County Tax Commissioner from the collection of said ad valorem taxes.
